

"So they left their father Zebedee in the boat along with the hired men and followed him." What did Zebedee think about all of this? His sons and his partners, James and John, suddenly left their post and followed Jesus. So there he stood in the boat with a crew of employees, but not one of his sons. We can't help but wonder whether Zebedee was in favor of this promise that his heirs would become "fishers of men." Most likely, this event was the cause of some familial tension.

Throughout the Gospels, Jesus instructs us to love and serve others for the love of God. But the Lord also makes it clear that our devotion to him is meant to trump our devotion to anything--or anyone--else. For our part, we are called to allow this divine allegiance to exist in those we love, even when it means a sacrifice for us as well. Parents for example, like Zebedee, are called to encourage their children to follow the Lord's call. A son or daughter's vocation to religious life certainly exemplifies this kind of sacrifice for a parent who might have had a different plan in mind. But in truth every son and daughter has a vocation from God and parents have the opportunity to support and assist their children as they seek to hear and follow God's special plan for their lives.

We don't know for sure how Zebedee responded to the vocation of his sons, but we know that James and John were counted among the Twelve Apostles and that their devotion and dedication helped to spread the Gospel to the ends of the earth. Regardless of what he might have thought as he stood in that boat, we can be quite sure that looking back now, Zebedee can rejoice heartily in the choice of his sons to leave their nets and follow Christ.


#### St. Mary's Annual Chili & Soup Supper

#### **How Our Parish Prays**



From Stephen's youth: My dad would go out for lunch with a friend who began meals saying grace so loudly, everyone stopped eating and bowed their heads. I thought, if I have a family, we're giving God thanks. Today, the reminder is heard in the Cross home: "God has given us an entire week, we will give Him this one hour. He has invited us; we're not going to tell Him no. As we hear at Mass: 'It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give God thanks." God isn't isolated to one hour of Mass. Crucifixes, Statues, Bibles, prayer cards and books are found in the house. A wall niche displays a statue of Mary. Grace before meals happens at home or away. A Hail Mary is prayed when an emergency vehicle goes by or aware of someone in need.

Stephen prays with the meditations in the In Conversation with God books: writings of the great saints on themes from daily Mass readings. He is drawn to Opus Deis' spirituality: seek holiness by doing quality work with a good work ethic; as Jesus did as a simple and poor carpenter in Nazareth.

Christine draws daily inspiration from The Catholic Mom's Prayer Companion, along with resources from women's groups - most recently Walking With Purpose. She uses the ibreviary app to pray with. Her go to saint is our Blessed Mother Mary. When feeling stressed, from studying for college finals to prepping for a cesarean delivery, reaching out to Mary in prayer brings her great peace and comfort.

Nathan loves his Bible Stories; favorites include: David & Goliath and Daniel in the Lion's Den. Abby's Bible is at her bedside; the Gospels of Jesus' life and teachings give guidance and hope. Like other young people, Ellen's spiritual life and friendship with Jesus took a huge leap at LEAD week before the Steubenville Conference: "I once knew of Jesus, but now I know him." She craves being with Jesus in daily prayer, daily Mass when she can, and adoration on Monday evenings. Ellen uses the laudate app-the #1 free Catholic app-to pray with. She shares, "the true test of our love for another is how much effort we put into that relationship."

A family tradition was eating at the Old Country Inn following Mass. They began with grace. One day a priest introduced himself and thanked them: "I was so happy to see your family making the sign of the cross and praying together. Your witness gives me hope and encouragement." We never know how our actions impact others - including a man brave enough to say grace so loudly while out to eat, that others took notice and followed.
