

LENTEN PRACTICES



Fast means to reduce the amount of food eaten. For Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 we eat one main meal a day, and two smaller meals. Eating between meals is not permitted. During Lent, we fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Abstinence is to not eat meat as a way to remember and honor the death of lesus on Good Friday. During Lent, those ages 14 and older abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent with exception to the Commemoration of St. Patrick. Bishop Amos has commuted the observance of the law of abstinence on Friday, March 17. That is, any who wish to take meat on Friday, March 17, may do so as long as they abstain from meat on some other day of that week (March 13-18).
