SCRIPTURE MEDITATION

Today is the birthday of the church. The church was born on Pentecost. But Pentecost is not a “once only” event. Pentecost continues to happen whenever church happens. When does church happen? When the Spirit comes to liberate a community, blowing them out of being stuck in any comfort zone into a world sometimes hostile, to proclaim with joy the gospel, a church happens. When the Spirit turns a group of frightened people into a people afire with Jesus’ love, church happens. When the Spirit comes upon a community and makes each person aware of his or her gift given for the good of others, whether they are part of that community or not, church happens. When a community knows the breath of Jesus breathing in them, showing itself in a spirit of forgiveness generously extended to others, church happens. And most of all, when the community of believers and gathers in the power of the Holy Spirit, who comes upon bread a wine to change it into the body and blood of Christ, enabling those who receive it to be more deeply transformed into the body of Christ, church happens.
