



Lauren, a native of Solon and recent graduate of Benedictine College in Atchison. Kansas, will be a missionary with The Culture Project, an initiative of young people set out to restore culture through the experience of virtue. Connor, an incoming senior Education & Theology major at Benedictine, has spent this summer as a youth minister to four parishes in Carroll, IA. Lauren and Connor met through One Love Ministry at Benedictine College, where they were empowered to speak to thousands of youth across the country through dynamic presentations about chastity, authentic love and virtue. On campus, they led a weekly formation program for hundreds of their peers based on Saint John Paul II's Theology of the Body. 


