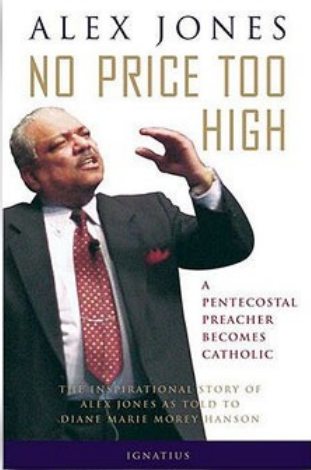
Think about using your talents and creativity to provide some unique items to donate this fall. All money raised goes back to the parish and youth groups. Donation forms can be found in the gathering space.
