**Pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy with us:**

In 1935, St. Faustina received a vision of an angel sent by God to chastise a certain city. She began to pray for mercy, but her prayers were powerless. She found herself pleading with God for mercy with words she heard interiorly. As she continued saying this inspired prayer, the angel became helpless and could not carry out the deserved punishment. The next day, as she was entering the chapel, she again heard this interior voice, instructing her how to recite the prayer that our Lord later called "the Chaplet." In subsequent revelations, the Lord made it clear that the Chaplet was not just for her, but for the whole world. ***Encourage souls to say the Chaplet which I have given you*** (1541). ***I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy*** (687). ***Through the***
