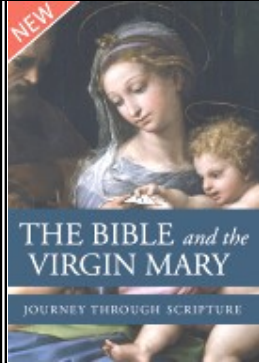
Annual Christmas Cookie Walk

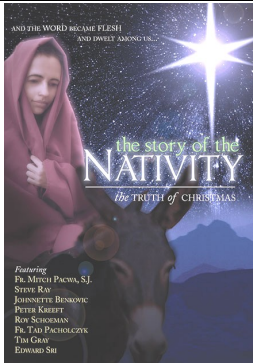
