Lent Begins on February 18. Masses on Ash Wednesday are 7:00 am and 6:30 pm. Ash Wednesday is a day of both fasting and abstinence. May the coming 40 days be a time of spiritual renewal as we prepare to celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus at Easter.

<u>To Fast</u> means to reduce the amount of food eaten. For Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 we eat one mai8l meal a day and two smaller meals, which, if added together, does not exceed the quantity of food in the main meal. During Lent we a=fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

<u>Abstinence</u> means not to eat meat as a way to remember and honor the death of Jesus on Good Friday. During Lent those 14 and older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.
