Grab your spouse and join us for DATE NIGHT: Saturday, February 13th 6-8:30 pm



FAST means to reduce the amount of food eaten. For Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 we eat one main meal a day, and two smaller meals which, if added together, does not exceed the quantity of food in the mean meal. During Lent we fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

ABSTINANCE to not eat meat as a way to remember and honor the death of Jesus on Good Friday. During Lent those 14 and older abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Friday of Lent.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS Wednesdays at 5:45pm beginning on February 17.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK may be received at all Masses on the weekend of February 20 & 21.
