





**LENT BEGINS ON MARCH 5.** Masses on Ash Wednesday are 7:00 am and 6:30 pm. Ash Wednesday is a day of both fasting and abstinence. May the coming 40 days be a time of spiritual renewal as we prepare to celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus at Easter.

FAST means to reduce the amount of food eaten. For Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 we eat one main meal a day, and two smaller meals which, if added together, does not exceed the quantity of food in the main meal. During Lent we fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

ABSTINANCE means not to eat meat as a way to remember and honor the death of Jesus on Good Friday. During Lent those 14 and older abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS begins on Wednesday March 12 at 5:45 pm.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK may be received at any of the Masses on the weekend of March 15-16.



#### SCRIPTURE MEDITATION

(Jerry Galipeau, World Library Publications) Last week Jesus' words may have sounded impossible. This week he sounds irresponsible. Don't worry, he says? Don't worry about what you will eat or drink or wear? Really? Right; no

problem. With global warming, hurricanes devastating communities, countries with unstable leaders gaining nuclear capability, record gun sales, savings for the future evaporating, paying off school debts overwhelming, finding full-time work so difficult, being told not to worry seems guite out of touch. But Jesus is not talking from the perspective of this world's analysis, but from the vantage point of a prophet announcing the coming of God's kingdom. He is calling us to get our priorities in order. There is nothing more important than living a life that trusts in God's goodness and care. God can be looked on as a mother who will never forget the child of her womb, never be without tenderness for her child. As Pope John Paul I once said, "God is the father, but God is also the mother." And this mother will never forget her children or abandon them.
