



### DID YOU KNOW...

The pectoral cross that Pope Francis wears was created by an Italian craftsman living in a village in Northern Italy. He created his one of a kind Good Shepherd Cross of silver, not gold. He didn't want to create an expensive article, thinking that it might appeal a bishop or abbot. It was purchased

by a retailer whose shop was a few steps from St.
Peter's Square. One day, in the Spring of 1998, a South-American priest
Walked into that shop, saw that pectoral cross, and decided to buy it. The
priest said he needed a present for a friend of his that had just been nominated Archbishop of Buenos Aires, -Archbishop Jorge Bergoglio.


