



Glory SCRIPTURE MEDITATION

Some moments in life are simply "glorious." Those special times that suddenly bless our lives, offering a meaning barely suspected, giving us a sense of well-being and joy,

allowing us to transcend our usual "ordinary" existence and pass over into a glimpse of heaven. A special celebration, an experience of nature, an intimate moment with a loved one, a sudden understanding of and appreciation for something of great importance – all can be deemed "glorious." The words "glory" and "glorify" occur five times in the opening verses of today's Gospel as Jesus prays to his Father. We are hearing Jesus' last prayer in John's Gospel. After telling the Father that his "hour" has come, when the Father will show the world his great love by allowing the Son to be "lifted up" (referring both to the Crucifixion and the Resurrection), Jesus asks the Father to give him glory so that he may in return glorify the Father. This glory he had with the Father before the world began. Such glory is to be our destiny.

What does it mean to you to have your life give glory to God and to have God give you glory?
