



Today we hear Moses receive God's name: "Lord." Some do not like calling God "Lord," saying it carries a sense of domination and oppression of others – even Jesus warned that his disciple "should not be like the Gentiles who lord it over others," oppressing them with their authority. But God redefines "Lord" in Exodus as one "gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in love and fidelity" (34.6). So we should not hesitate to call God "Lord" or to call Jesus
