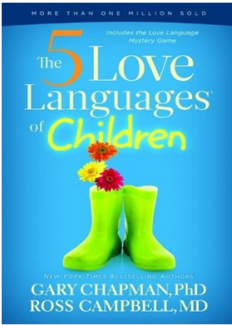
Highlights of Pastoral Parish Council Minutes of June 15, 2015

The Organ Fund Drive has received approximately \$41,700 of the needed \$59,000.

The Finance & Administration Commission and the Cemetery Committee have voted to take down the old church. In its place a chapel with areas for the cremains of the cremated to be entombed could be built. The remaining space would be used for grave plots.

A new format for Pastoral Parish Council meetings where there will be a business meeting one month and an action or work session the next was voted on and passed unanimously. July's meeting will be a business meeting with a work session in August. Information on work session topics will be made available to the congregation via the church bulletin, Pastoral Parish Council Minutes and from Chairpersons of Commissions which would be affected by topics to be covered.

Pastoral Parish Council members will be available for discussions with the congregation following Masses of the weekend of July 4th and 5th.
