SCRIPTURE MEDITATION

We remember Peter and Paul as the two great pillars of the church in its first days. Both were martyred in the city of Rome during the time of Nero. Both were unlikely candidates for martyrdom before they met Jesus. Peter had been a fisherman; Paul a tentmaker by trade and a Pharisee by education. Then each met Christ. Peter was casting his nets when Jesus called. Paul was on the way to Damascus to throw some followers of Jesus into prison. Meeting Jesus led both of them to end up behind bars, where we find them in the first two readings. Herod has arrested Peter. Paul is presented as writing this letter from prison. But we remember them as two men who found freedom in Christ. Their example calls to us across the centuries. Peter’s faith, as the “rock” to whom Jesus entrusted the community of believers, still brings stability, now through his successor Pope Francis. Paul’s zeal, burning through his letters, continues to inflame our hearts. Each heard and responded in his own way to Jesus’ call.
