Eucharistic Adoration: Friday after the 7am Mass until noon.


Sickness: Please notify the pastor 624-2228 when someone is ill or has been hospitalized. Sacrament of Anointing is available.

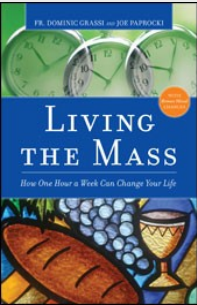

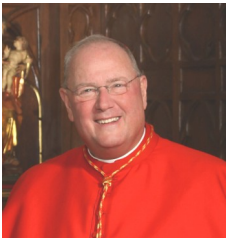
