





#### **Gospel Meditation**




Our humanity bleeds through today's Gospel passages in more ways than one. We see both elation and fall, hope in the midst of the darker sides of our natures. If we allow it, these Gospels hold a mirror to our own fickle hearts. The crowds cry "Hosanna" and the Apostles profess allegiance unto death. In a manner of days - even hours - Jesus is betrayed, abandoned, denied, condemned, tortured, and executed. As God, he could have stopped this horrific narrative from unfolding, but he doesn't. He allows free will to play itself out.

There are nearly two millennia between this spectacle and us. We can stand safely removed, if we choose. But Lent invites us to return to this story. Lent invites us to find ourselves in the people we encounter there. Are we the repentant woman at Bethany? Are we naysayers of such lavish piety? Have we acted in a way that betrays those we love or denies what we know to be good and true? Have we fallen asleep in our faith? Have we unfairly accused others of a crime or immorality we imagine, though perhaps they didn't commit? Do we help others carry their burdens? Do we stand in solidarity with those who suffer? Do we care for the dying?

This week, take up today's Gospel again. Look carefully at the Passion narrative and sit with it in silence. Find yourself in the story and ponder its meaning for your own life. Journey with Jesus to the foot of the Cross so that you too may say, along with the faithful centurion, "truly this man was the Son of God!"

#### **How Our Parish Prays**



Ben, Terry, Rose, Michelle, Will and Joe McAtee After a recent Saturday archery meet in Davenport, Michelle was on her phone looking for a nearby Mass when Terry suggested they go to the Sacred Heart Cathedral. The whole family, clad in orange, attended Mass together, as they do every weekend. Despite the parent's work schedules including weekends and the activity schedules of four children, attending Mass as a family is a priority, the most important part of their week.

Eating dinner together as a family is also important, even if it is at 8:00pm after practices and chores. With the meal blessing, a prayer rock is passed around as they each share thankfulness or prayers for those in need. Sometimes it stalls on the youngest, Will, as he gives thanks for each of the livestock. It has circled their table hundreds of times. Each room has a crucifix hanging over the doorway, reminding them of God's presence.

Michelle shared that the faith practices taking place in her and her siblings families, were passed on to them by parents and grandparents. Each Sunday they went to the 7:00am Mass, followed by breakfast and chores together. When staying overnight with 90 year old grandma Eileen, they both got down on their knees for evening prayer. She remembers walking past her parent's bedroom around midnight, after her dad finished second shift, and seeing him on his knees praying by his bedside. When she reminds her kids to say a quick prayer thanking God before going to sleep, they remind her that Grandpa Daryl says it doesn't count unless you are on your knees.

On the night St. Mary's hosted the Tour of the Relics – their family had a busy evening along with a lot of homework, yet they came. Michelle shared the saints really came alive to her kids. It was a peaceful and moving experience to be among the 100+ saints, a connection which continues to grow since that evening. Several months earlier, Michelle shared with us how her dad took some of her family to the tour when in Cedar Rapids. This prompted our parish to invite them to Solon. And somehow we were bumped to the top of a four year wait list.

Pope Francis often speaks of the ripple effect the faith of parents and grandparents has throughout generations - for the good or for the bad. As he did in this tweet: "How important grandparents are for family life, for passing on the human and religious heritage so essential for each and every society!" Thank you Grandma Eileen.




