



#### **Gospel Meditation**



Tiny fingers and toes. A little yawn. A loud cry. An infant wrapped in swaddling clothes. "What will this child be?" It is a question every parent asks time and time again. As first steps are taken, as personalities emerge, as a child shows interest in reading or drawing or climbing, the question is on our lips. "What will this child be?" This question is asked as John the Baptist is born. Will he be a priest like his father? Does his strange, unexpected name signal a departure from that inheritance? Could Elizabeth and Zechariah ever have predicted what would be?

Under the tutelage of his priestly father, John "became strong in spirit." As an adult, John would retreat into the desert to preach repentance. He would attract a large following and eventually attract the attention of the rulers of the day. He would point out the adulterous ways of King Herod and would find himself in prison. Eventually, he would be beheaded. But today, he is a child, an infant newly born.

On this special feast, we're reminded of the great humility required of parents. The character formation, the discipline and encouragement, the violin lessons and soccer practices every parental effort is subjected to the decisions of the child themself. Even children on a sure track by high school graduation transform under life's circumstances. Entrusting our children to God can be incredibly intimidating. "What will this child be," especially when that transformation lies outside of my control? John the Baptist's story might not have ended as his parents imagined. But he is celebrated as the greatest of the prophets, as the one who prepared the way for the Messiah. Here is the hope of all Christian parents—that our children would be raised in such a way that when people meet them, they meet Jesus Christ.



#### **How Our Parish Prays**



Often families reach a time when they move from a passive to an intentional faith. While at a kindergarten orientation for Regina, daughter Rosey returned from a session wearing a crown sharing: "this means I love Jesus and Jesus loves me." It struck a chord: Tim and KellyAnn wanted their Catholic Faith to be more profound in their lives. Sunday Mass attendance went from occasionally to every weekend. As Tim and KellyAnn participated in retreats, conferences, adoration and daily Mass when possible, they grew in faith and friendship with Christ; sometimes at different paces, but each appreciating what once seemed like too much. A recent joy was preparing for and having their marriage celebrated as a sacrament last summer.

A large part of their prayer lives is the Rosary. After Rosey received Great Grandma Rosella's Rosary while preparing for Communion – they thought of the power of all those rosaries Great Grandma must have prayed throughout her lifetime. Now, Rosey and Alex pray the Rosary together as dad drives to school. During Advent, they pray it at night when possible. Tim says those 20 minutes of prayer center his day on God. When he catches himself drifting from God; he can quickly pull himself back just as he does when praying. Life for KellyAnn as wife, mother and also a doctor gets overwhelming. She finds great strength from praying the Rosary and attending weekday Mass when possible. No longer is she depending on herself to fix everything, she knows to lean on God who makes all things possible.

They each love to read – the Bible, about their faith or saints. The children have favorite books and stories. (Alex loves his Children's Bible and Noah's Ark) KellyAnn likes the writings of modern saints including Sr. Faustina, St. Maximillian and especially St. John Paul II. She's moved by his deep respect for God's plan for women in his writings. Tim likes the stories of redemption: like St. Ignatius of Loyola and St. Paul who had powerful experiences which turned their lives around. While there was not a "struck blind" moment in their lives – KellyAnn and Tim do share a story of redemption, of being less to being more...and there's no turning back once you discover the joy of a life in Christ.




