- Finance (Sue Schmitt)
 - o Per Bob Huber:
 - Roof over church is finished
 - There are windows that need repairing
 - Roof over gathering space and tower will be done when the weather improves (as part of Phase I).
 - Roof over offices and hall gathering space will be done later as part of Phase II.
 - \circ Adam Stahle is putting the budget together and the Finance committee will meet again on 06/19. Budget is due to diocese in August.
 - Will also discuss tithing to charitable organizations.

Cemetery Meeting update

- Have received enough donations to complete the archway. Need to get the bids in for the work.
- Working on getting get bids for Mary Statue
- Need to get all footings poured for the statue, corner posts, etc.
- There is no additional information from the city as to when they will be lowering the street level. Cannot do the sidewalk until after that is done.
- Still need to get confirmation on the footings for the columbarium., and firm up sizes of the other structures..
- o Bob is collecting all of the separate bids that are required from welders, concrete, etc.
- Fall Festival Mark Roskopf called Adam Date will be September 29, and a committee has been formed.

Church Parking

- b. Need to have tables set up in hall for palms. Use red tablecloths. Need to get palms out before each service and cover with table cloths. Start in hall for all masses.
- c. June will send an email to ask for Knights in regalia for all masses if they are available. Will process outside only on Sunday 10:30 mass if weather is good.
- d. We will set up the palm banners in church but won't be carried. 2 behind the altar.
- e. No side wall banners for Palm Sunday.

7. Holy Thursday – April 18 – 7 pm

Washing of feet will be the same process as last year. Fr. Tim will get 12 initial volunteers.

8. Good Friday – April 19 – Stations of the Cross at 2:30, service at 3 pm.

9. Easter – April 20-21

a. Easter vigil time will be 8:30 PM. - No baptisms this year.

b. Fr. Tim will select readers and servers for Easter Vigil. Signups for others. Fr. Tim will decide if we will do all readings, etc.

10. April 28 – 2nd Sunday of Easter – Divine Mercy Sunday

a. Encourage parishioners to attend at St. Wenceslas. Put event in bulletin and perhaps announcements

February- The names for the Pro-Life interest have been notified already because 40 Days for Life began on Ash Wednesday and continues until Palm Sunday. Also, information has gone out to those who are involved with our legislative issues and respond to those much needed areas.

Dispersed the lists for: K of C Blood Drive (Kevin Hayes), Health and Care (Nancy Upmeyer), Building and rectory helpers (Bob Huber), Mary's Meals 5K run/asst. (Theresa Bonnema) Care Center Bingo (?), and grounds asst.(?) Free Lunch, (Patty Benzing)

MARCH- There will be a FREE special preview of UNPLANNED coming up on the 28th of March at the Sycamore Mall Marcus Theaters. Go online to reserve a place. It will show after that on Friday, but not for free.

*MARCH- Submitting the 2019 Budget for Social Action to the Parish Council for approval.

The other Social Action areas of interest are: Food Pantry (?), Ronald McDonald House, Catholic Worker House, Adopt a Grandparent, Chains Interrupted, Bridgehaven, Middle School Mentors (Diane Wurzer), Transportation for people who need to go to appointments, get groceries, etc.

We had additional requests for Providing the Holy Rosary before Mass. I believe that is in place and happening now. I know it is being prayed prior to the 8:30 and 10:30 with Mike Montgomery leading.

Bible Study (I will check in with Julie. We did have a Bible timeline study last year that was good)

Rosary/ Chaplet for Hospice (?) I need to review my notes and ask more questions.

Hope Lodge in Iowa City-provide a meal for a resident (I will check with Cheryl Geistkemper as to how we can help get the word out. At this point, I believe the bulletin will be our best source of communicating the needs.

American Cancer Society (same as above)

It is exciting how many people have shown interest in these 16 areas of Social Action. I am working as best that I can to get the information to these volunteers so they can begin getting involved in the areas that they are wanting to be involved.

April- The "Four Churches of Solon" have been staying busy with our Mental Awareness Ministry. We had two excellent speakers at the Methodist Church last month who told us what it is like to live having personality disorders. We will begin promoting the NAMI Walk at the Terry Trueblood Park in Iowa City. We have a team registered: we are called *Solon Striders (Walking With Purpose)*. We hope many of our parishioners can sign up to walk or sponsor someone who is walking.

May- The month of Mary, Our Heavenly Mother. Mother's Day

June- Father's Day month, St. Mary Choir is traveling to Italy to sing at 5 different venues.
