## 6:50 **– Topics**

- 1. Shared reading for Council Forming Intentional Disciples, Chapters 3 and 4.
  - (p 75 Discipleship is central/essential.... Surrender to the church...spirituality...relationship with Christ, etc... .how do we grow that at St. Mary?
  - Are we losing people? Are people drifting away? Per Father, there is a general sense of despair.
  - Unique opportunity to expand our church. How can we fill the void, and the time.
  - Email that just came out from the church has a lot more positive spin. Much more welcoming than previous notes.
  - As leaders in the church, we need to set an example and encourage others to get back, spread the word, be welcoming and be positive.
  - Consider for future discussion: What else can we be doing as a council...short term and long term to evangelize and help get back on track?
  - Chapter 4 Baptism, Eucharist...people who miss going to Mass, and miss the experience of being there with others and the normal numbers...." Mass designed to nurture the spiritual life of those there....." Helps to experience it with others.
  - Per Father...send paragraph on our experience....If we give witness to our faith by putting it into words, it helps others to grasp it at a grass roots level.

- Chapter 4 description of difference b/w subjective and objective redemption. Brings to mind how much we state in the creed, but how much do we really understand that? We may not necessarily reflect on each sentence and what it means. (7<sup>th</sup> grade will focus on the Creed in religious ed this year.) What do you say to someone who asks you "are you saved?". Our faith is a huge quest…never at the end of it. Need to bring knowledge forward to share with the next generation and others.
