Construction on the Rosary Garden continues and significant progress has been made over the past couple of weeks! I am sure you will agree when you check on the structure.

The exit to the backyard has been greatly improved and much more accessible. The continuous flow of the path will allow for everyone to pray and enjoy the Rosary Garden. This HUGE undertaking is meant to benefit everyone as we continue to grow our faith and share the life and love of Jesus.

We are still in need of additional donations to help cover the full cost of the project, and invite you to consider how you can be a part of this devotion.

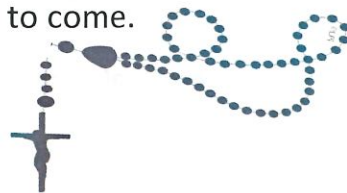
The completed walking path will be a full rosary (6 Our Father and 53 Hail Mary granite beads). Included around the edge will be *five* granite benches (available to sponsor on a first come basis), a Mary of the Assumption statue donated by the Knights of Columbus in the center, and beautiful plants to enhance the landscaping. The professional installation was important for the ground to be properly graded for drainage, accessible for all ages and abilities, as well as to ensure a long lasting structure.

There are multiple ways for everyone to support the construction of the rosary garden through memorials, donations and sponsorship. The different giving levels include five (5) engraved granite benches available as memorials, mentions on the Patrons plaque to be permanently displayed in the Gathering Space, as well as brass leaves added to the Giving Trees in the Gathering Space. A breakdown of the giving levels is noted on the donation form.

On August 15th, the Feast Day of the Assumption of Mary into Heaven, St. Mary parish will be celebrating the 25th anniversary of the dedication of our church building. Bishop Zinkula will be here to celebrate Mass at 6:30PM, with a reception to follow. Included in the celebration of this monumental occasion, Bishop Zinkula will consecrate the new rosary garden.

A blue print of the project is posted in the Gathering Space along with donation forms. Be sure to look out the windows to see the progress made so far and in the weeks to come.
